2024 JACK PETTEYS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jack Petteys Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to one outstanding male student-athlete from Brush, Ft. Morgan, and Sterling High Schools. The scholarship is limited to students who plan to acquire a bachelor's degree. The scholarship may be used at any two or four-year accredited college or university as long as the two-year college or university is part of a plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to finish a bachelor's degree. The scholarship is renewable for a total of four years if a minimum of a 2.5 GPA average is maintained. The amount of the scholarship is \$6,000 per year, renewable, up to a maximum of \$24,000 over four years of school.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

- 1. Scholarship applications are to be completed by the applicant and returned to the school official in charge of scholarships by April 1. Applications received after that day will not be considered.
- 2. An application containing all the following items must be completed for a student to be considered as a candidate.
 - a. Application form completed by the student.
 - b. Transcript of high school courses and grades, containing SAT/ACT scores, class rank and size of graduating class. An SAT score of 1100 or ACT score of 22 is necessary to apply.
 - c. A signed personal letter from the applicant (one page maximum) indicating why he is applying for the scholarship and outlining his college goals and objectives for the future.
 - d. Two completed Personal Reference Forms with attached signed letters from qualified people outside the school system (e.g.: doctor, minister, neighbor, or employer) who know the student well.
- 3. Criteria to be considered in selecting a candidate: a boy must be in the top 25% of his class, be taking college preparatory classes, be a U.S. citizen, score at least 1100 on his SAT test or 22 on his ACT test (super scoring is not allowed), show college-level academic promise, have lettered in a sport, and have very strong qualities of leadership and character.
- 4. The winner will be notified early in May.
- 5. Recipients are not allowed to receive more than \$3,000 annually in other renewable scholarships from sources other than their college. One-time grants are not included in that total. If a recipient receives offers of more than \$3,000, he will have to turn one or more of them down or decline the Jack Petteys Memorial Scholarship. While the amount of scholarship monies received from the student's college is not restricted, the total amount of scholarship monies cannot exceed the cost of tuition, fees, room and board as verified by the college.
- 6. If a winner chooses not to accept the scholarship, it will be awarded to the next qualified candidate.
