The Ken Amen Memorial Scholarship is established by Ken's family to honor the faithful servant, agriculture steward and community leader that Ken was. Ken's love for Jesus, his family and community and his passion for agriculture are all blessings the family strives to pass on through generations to come.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Ken Amen Memorial Scholarship recognizes confident young people who excel in core leader areas of agriculture, community involvement and faithful servant leadership. The scholarship amount will be given as follows: \$1000 to current college students (increments of \$500 with a maximum of 2 recipients) and \$1500 to current high school seniors (increments of \$500 with a maximum of 3 recipients).

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Any Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, or Washington County graduating senior with a minimum 2.5 GPA
OR
Current college student with a minimum 2.5 GPA that previously graduated from a Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, or Washington County High School.
2. Preference will be given to 4-H/FFA members that have strong leadership and community service interests such as livestock showing, farm involvement, or youth ministry/church activities.

TERMS:

1. Upon proof of enrollment to the scholarship committee, funds will be awarded half in the Fall Semester and half in the Spring Semester
2. Recipient must attend either a junior college, four-year college, trade, or technical school
