As an authorized small vehicle operator with the Morgan County School District you are to always follow the law when it comes to carrying students in a district vehicle.

Drivers may NEVER carry more than one child per working seatbelt available in any non-bus vehicle. This includes Suburban's, cars, pickups, etc. All children must wear a seatbelt at all times when the keys are in the ignition. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Drivers may NEVER carry more than 15 passengers (plus driver equals 16 total) in any small bus. Carrying more than 15 passengers requires a CDL B license with P and S endorsements, a valid medical card, and registration with the district as a current school bus driver.

Any driver that breaks these laws/regulations will be subject to disciplinary action up to and possibly including termination, in addition to placing themselves at great risk regarding liability and further legal issues.
